






First Call for project proposals

5 April to 31 May 2022

134 proposals submitted72 projects approved





First call - first lessons learned

Eligibility

- Status of the policy responsible authority
- At least one Investment for jobs & growth goal programme

Description of the policy instrument addressed

Quality

- Innovative character (Interreg Europe cannot finance follow up projects)
- Geographical coverage beyond transnational cooperation areas (e.g., MED covers Slovenia, Bulgaria and part of France)
